This funding will be used to

- Lift the School Mean Score in Year 3 and Year 5 to similar or above the Australian National Mean.
- Improve the number of students assessed in NAPLAN achieving in the Upper Two Band Levels to similar, or above national percentage score.
- Increase the report card distributions for achievement in English, Mathematics and Science for students to an upward trend of %C or higher.
- Improve opportunities and supports for student wellbeing by implementing school wide strategies to increase percentage of satisfaction for parents, staff and students in School Opinion Survey data.

Our initiatives include

- Implementing quality professional development for staff on key initiatives of Writing and wellbeing.
- Improving teacher capability through focused coaching and collegial engagement opportunities involving the teaching of Writing, Number Facts and Reading.
- Continue participating in North Coast Region NCR Teachers First Initiative - Numeracy, Noosa Hinterland Cluster and NCR Developing Computational Fluency.
- Providing targeted support for early years. Investigate - Early Start - Literacy and Literacy Continuum materials.
- Investigating Kids Matter (an Australian Primary Schools Mental Health Initiative) or other recommended wellbeing programs.
- Continuing STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) specialist Prep to Year 6 to work and plan with teachers.
- Expanding on current whole school intervention strategies (eg, MiniLit) that are responsive to student and school data to support more students with learning and wellbeing needs.
- Providing a Prep Pre-Start program to transition new students.
- Providing greater opportunities for leadership team members to be engaged as Instructional Leaders for collegial engagement and classroom interaction.


