## Term 4 Swimming

Tewantin State School employs private swimming coaches to complement our school swimming program. The program has been extremely successful in previous years and is well supported by parents. During Term 4, children in Years Prep - 6 will have 8 x 30 minute lessons in our school pool.

Lessons will commence in Week 1 from Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> October 2022

For students to commence lessons from the 4<sup>th</sup> October the Online Permission Form below must be completed and payment made by Friday 16<sup>th</sup> September. It is essential the school receive payment prior to the cut-off date and various payment methods are available including: BPoint, Eftpos and cash.

Our school pool is heated and there are some essential items your child will need for swimming lessons and these include:-

- togs, towel and goggles (optional)
- sun shirt/rash shirt is also required as a means of protection from the sun's harmful UV rays (no t-shirts please).

It is requested that all personal belongings be clearly labelled and brought to and from the pool in a "swimming" bag of some sort.

Generally speaking, swimming will take place unless severe weather conditions prevail (such as torrential rain, lightning, and thunder storms) in which case alternative arrangements will be made. Also, the weather conditions can change quite quickly, so if it is raining before school on your child's swimming day, please don't assume swimming will be cancelled.



## Visual Arts News

Week 6 & Week 7

I had the pleasure of taking Mrs Hill's Visual Art classes the last two weeks.

Here are some highlights from our studies of the art of Eric Carle. He is the author and illustrator of the well known and lived picture book, "The Very Hungry Caterpillar".

The students found pictures of nature and cut out shapes from them to mimic the shapes that made the butterfly.

Another study was of texture and colour. The students explored how to achieve a textural effect through crayon rubbings of materials such as hessian, bubble wrap and plastic chair grooves.

The third exploration was based on colour and pattern using tempura paint sticks to imitate the colours and patterns in The butterfly wings and the flower, bee and grass from another book by Eric Carle.

The final artwork was created by drawing a butterfly and using collage to decorate the wings in a similar style to that of Eric Carle.

The classes also had some cartooning workshops to celebrate Bookweek.


