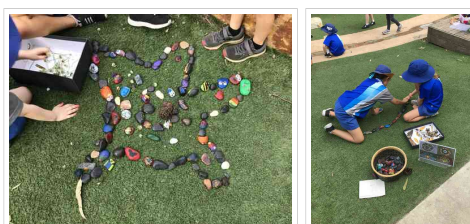
August
