This funding will be used to

- Address the North Coast Regional Priority of transition for social and academic development for early learners Prep – Year Two.
- Improve consistency in Report Card distributions for Achievement in English, Mathematics and Science for students with an upward trend of percentage of students with C or higher.
- Improve opportunities and supports for student learning and wellbeing by implementing school wide strategies to increase percentage of satisfaction for Parents, Staff and Students in School Opinion Survey data.
- Improve the percentage of students achieving a C or higher standard, with consistency of data between Semester One and Semester Two.

Our initiatives include

- Implementing quality professional development for staff to provide clear, consistent understanding and implementation of the Australian Curriculum and the use of Achievement Standards through the use of collaborative year level planning meetings.
- Developing teacher knowledge and understanding of the P-10 Australian Curriculum content descriptors and achievement standards by designing and supporting processes for robust intra-school and inter-school moderation.
- Providing staff training for the implementation of the North Coast Region – Early Years: Connecting the Dots K-2 school based action plan.
- Continuing whole school intervention strategies that are responsive to student and school data to support students with learning (e.g. Minilit and extension classes).
- Implementing Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) a whole school program – ‘Wellbeing’ school priority.
- Investing in professional development for teaching staff to develop knowledge and pedagogy about modelled writing, shared/joint construction, interactive writing, guided writing and independent writing.
